



Nations Cup 2010 – Saint Pierre Quiberon July 19-23 2010

Here the latest news about the Nations Cup 2010 in Saint Pierre Quiberon in France.

The event is hosted by the ENVSN, the French national sailing academy . The entrance fee is € 120,-, including T-shirt and happy hours.



The location for the Nations Cup 2010, the Baie the Quiberon, is famous for its sailing conditions. It's for a good reason the French have the trials for their Olympic Sailing Team at Saint Pierre Quiberon. A five star sailing spot in a subtropical surrounding. The sea breeze, starting very early in the afternoon, guarantees great sailing conditions. The sea is warmer than north and west of Brittany. The racing area has very little current (less than 0,7 knots).

The village of Saint Pierre Quiberon has 2000 residents and is situated at the Quiberon

Peninsula, South of Carnac. The coast consists of beautiful beaches sheltered by rocks.

For non sailing family members there is plenty to do in the area. The city of Vannes is situated on the site of a river. It has a beautiful old centre with narrow streets and colourful traditional houses. By ferry you can go to islands like Ile aux Moines, well known for its oysters. Or discover the megalithic

sites: more than 3000 menhirs stand in this area. Carnac is a nice town close to Saint Pierre Quiberon. At the harbour are very nice restaurants where you can enjoy great food for reasonable prices. During the opening party on monday family members can meet and plan trips together.



Accommodation is offered at walking distance from your boat. The ENVSN can accommodate 140 people. You have a choice from 111 single and double rooms, right next to the sea. Prices are € 20 or € 32 a night, breakfast included. To make a reservation, mail to accueil@envsn.fr. For those of you who don't speak French, at the end of this document there is an example of an email you can use for making a reservation.

You will receive a confirmation of your reservation in which you'll be asked to make a deposit of 20% of the total fee.

To take your Solo abroad, you formally need a registration document. More information you can find on the website of the RYA (boating abroad).
