Arrival

The code for Gate Four is **7162**. The gate is accessible 24 hours a day with this code. This code is also for the pedestrian gate to the left of Reception in the main building entrance.

Dinghy Park (see the attached site plan for zones)

Solo sailors please put your dinghies in **Zones 3 & 4**.

Europe sailors please put your dinghies in **Zones 5 & 7**.

Please put your road trailers in **Zones 8, 9 & 10**.

Parking

All vehicles are to be parked in the main gravel car park, over the road, opposite the main building. Vehicles are only permitted in the dinghy park to drop off and pick up dinghies.

Registration

Registration is between 09:30 to 10:00 on Saturday in Room 4, which is on the balcony of the Event Hall.

Lockers & Changing Rooms

Lockers are available in the changing room corridor. Keys may be obtained from Reception with a £10 cash deposit, which is returned when the key is returned to Reception. We kindly request that no kit bags or personal items are left in the changing rooms so as not to inconvenience others and for your security.

Cafeteria

The cafeteria is open from 08:00 on Saturday and 07:30 on Sunday, serving breakfast, lunch, snacks, hot and cold drinks. Packed lunches or baguettes/sandwiches may be ordered from the cafeteria to take on the water. The closing time will depend on the days racing and social events.

Reception

Early Arrivals


Competitors that are arriving on days prior to the event may put dinghies in the same areas as specified above.
