### Notice of Race

#### 1 RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

The rules and regulations of Loch Tummel Sailing Club shall be followed and will be available on the Official Notice Board.

#### 2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing Authority.

#### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 Racing will be for nominated classes.

3.2 The Classes will be Solo,ILCA6,ILCA7,RS200,RS400 & General Handicap for any sailing boat with a recognized PY Number

#### 4 FEES

The entry fees are as follows:

Single Hander £30 Double Hander £40

#### 5 SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration:

Competitors shall register in the clubhouse on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> September from 0930. There will be a competitor briefing at 11:30.

5.2 Racing Programme:

The detailed programme will be published in the Sailing Instructions. The warning signal for the first race on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> September will not be before 12:57 and on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> September will not be before 10:27. The Schedule is for 4 Races per Day

#### 6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 The sailing instructions will be available online before the event

## **7 VENUE**

Races will be sailed in the waters West of Queens View Loch Tummel

## **8 THE COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be round the cans for General Handicap class and Windward/Leeward for the others.

## **9 PROTESTS**

The Exoneration Penalty and the Advisory Hearing and RYA Arbitration of the RYA Rules Disputes Procedures will be available

## **10 SCORING**

The scoring system will be detailed in the sailing instructions.

## **11 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction includes mobile telephones.

## **12 RIGHTS TO USE NAMES AND LIKENESSES**

Competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the event.

## **13 SAFETY REGULATIONS**

The Sailing instructions will specify that, all competitors shall wear a personal flotation device at all times when afloat, except briefly when changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits and dry suits are not considered personal flotation devices. This changes rule 40.

## **14 LIABILITY –**

Risk Statement

RRS Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: “The responsibility for a boat’s decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.”

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omission;
- d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;

- e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;

## **17 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3 million per event or the equivalent.

## **18 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

Please be ware that the Etape cycle race will be running from Pitlochry on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> September, access to the club on that day *may only be possible via* the Foss Road from Pitlochry
